Cathy has served from being Interim City Manager to Director of Parks & Recreation. She has worked for 7 City Managers, Dozens of Councilmembers, 24 Parks & Recreation Commissioners, and supervised hundreds of recreation leaders. Many of our Councilmembers have come from serving on the P&R Commission. Parks & Recreation have been affectionately referred to as the Fun Department.

Her career started early with a good roll model. Her father worked in Los Angeles Parks and Recreation. Before there were automatic sprinklers she would hop in the pick-up



truck with her dad to turn on the sprinklers by hand. Her first job was a Rec Leader. After graduating college she worked for the City of Rosemead for five years and then came back to Temple City in 1985 to begin her career in Parks and Recreation. She was promoted to Director of P&R in 2001 and being Assistant City Manager from 2003 to 2007 and again in 2009.

Some of the challenges Cathy has faced are greater expectations in services, staff turnover, taking on new duties as maintenance for trees and parkways, on top of all that there was the big windstorm of 2011.

She will leave her position with some of her favorite events: The 9/11 Remembrance, Moving Wall, and the 50th Anniversary Celebration. I think she has to be very fond of Light's On Temple City, the Veteran's Monument at Temple City Park in 2016, Halloween Carnival, Breakfast with the Easter Bunny, and Camp-A-Palooza.

Her motto has been: "You don't need to know how it's done, you need to know how to manage people". We wish Cathy all the best for this new chapter in her life!!
