He primarily investigates identity theft, credit and check fraud and other financial crimes. Also, he is one of the defensive tactics instructors there and one of the womens self defense class instructors.

These are some of the common Fraud Schemes that Mike alerted us to: Advance Fee Schemes, Business, Counterfeit Prescription Drugs, Credit Card, Against Seniors, Funeral and Cemetery, Health Care and Insurance, Identity Theft, Internet, Investment, Letter of Credit, Market Manipulation "Pump & Dump"



Nigerian Letter or "419", Non-Delivery of Merchandise, Online Vehicle Sale, Ponzi Schemes, Prime Bank Note, Pyramid Schemes, Redemption/Strawman/Bond, Reverse Mortgage Scams, Telemarketing.

I found all of these on the FBI website with detailed explanations. Tips from Mike included: Don't put outgoing mail at your mailbox or deposit in the blue P.O. containers, take to the Post Office. Don't use your debit card, it comes out of your bank account now. Don't lose sight of your credit card in a restaurant. Set up alerts for credit card purchases, he recommended anything over \$1, I have mine set to \$25.
