## THIS TUESDAY

April Lamie will speak about Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (TAPS). It is a program that supports families that have lost a military loved one.

## LAST TUESDAY

We welcomed Los Angeles County Fire Captain Mo Khazaal. I did not take too many notes because they were supposed to send their powerpoint presentation. I will do the best I can with my limited notes.

They get more wildland and brush fires than anyone else. It is almost impossible for them to train for every emergency. They bring with them their fire truck which has at least 500 gallons of water. 84% of their 911 calls are going to be medical emergencies, the remaining 16% are going to be house or structure fires.

This year is the 50th anniversary of having paramedics in the LAFD. I remember Supervisor Kenneth Hahn starting the program. The popular TV show Emergency depicted their activities. The program was also initiated by doctors and nurses saying they could begin receiving life saving help at the scene rather than waiting to get help at the hospital.

Staffing has not kept up with the demand. From 2008 to 2018 there has been a 50% increase in the number of calls. 911 calls are one the rise as more people don't recognize a true medical emergency. LAFD uses helicopters in their fire fighting and life saving calls. Each Sikorsky Helicopter is actually a converted armed services model that is converted to their use and a cost of \$18 million each.
