STATE OF THE CITY

On February 23 Temple City Mayor Tom Chavez stated the city remains a safe, financially-sound community where residents and businesses alike can thrive. Mayor Chavez told the audience at First Baptist Church that the experts at Safewise. com yet again had Temple City on its list of California's 50 safest municipalities. He said much of the credit goes to Temple City's acclaimed Neighborhood Watch

Meanwhile, greater efficiency in government allowed Temple City to reduce General Fund spending by 3 percent compared to the previous fiscal year. The city also took in more money than expected because of rising property values, more construction and a robust environment for retail sales. Reserves were bolstered by \$2 million to \$20 million, an increase of 11 percent. "And all of this was done while leaving untouched our high quality of services Temple City has come to expect, if not making them better," Mayor Chavez said.



Looking ahead, Mayor Chavez said Temple City needs to tackle the issue of revitalizing its downtown core. And

essential to that, he added, is learning what stakeholders want.
"What is our vision for downtown?" Mayor Chavez asked. "We can't arrive at our preferred destination unless we know where we're going." Earlier this month, the City Council agreed that Las Tunas Drive would not be narrowed as any part of revitalization efforts. The Council had been considering a proposal to reduce the traffic capacity of Las Tunas from two lanes in each direction to one so angled parking could be added. Instead, Mayor Chavez said, "there is consensus a different approach can help us better achieve our aims."

Mayor Chavez noted that increased parking has been a priority of the business community's. To that end, he announced as many as 90 new parking spaces in two lots could come online in the next few years. A major recreational amenity - the Live Oak Park Walking Trail - was announced during the speech. Mayor Chavez said the half-mile-long rubberized path is expected to be complete by early summer.

In addition, Mayor Chavez said work soon will begin on a veterans' memorial in Temple City Park, with the dedication anticipated for November.
