Metro is the county's planner, builder and operator for our regions transportation system. Lilian presented Metro's future plan to ease traffic in the region. She also answered questions regarding Metro's bus, rail and highway projects.

The Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension is extending the existing Gold Line east from Pasadena. The first phase will travel more than 11 miles from Sierra Madre Villa Station to Azusa.

Phase 1 includes new stations at: Arcadia, Monrovia, Duarte/

City of Hope, Irwindale, Azusa Downtown, APU/Citrus College.
The Foothill Extension Construction Authority has completed construction between Pasadena and Azusa. The second phase will continue the line for 12 miles east from Azusa to Montclair. Funding

is currently being sought for this segment. Phase 2 includes new stations at: Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont, Montclair. All this can happen with another 1/2 percent sales tax for forty years.
