Connie Franks is a resident of Pasadena and the copartner of Hannah's Children's Home She is the mother of three daughters and grandmother to four. She has been the Executive Director of Hannah's since its founding in 1989.

Connie grew up wanting to be a social worker. They help children from newborn to 21 years old and Foster Care to the age of 24. Their services include the counties of Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Riverside, Orange, and Ventura.

The mission of Hannah's Children's Homes is to provide safe and nurturing environments for children while working to preserve families and establish permanency. The ultimate goal

is to empower and strengthen at-risk families through culturally sensitive educational training, therapeutic services and interventions.

Almost 900,000 children each year in America are abused or neglected, one every 36 seconds. Forty percent of these children get no services at all after the initial investigation. Each year, more than 800,000 children spend time in foster care. On any given night, 200,000 children are homeless -1 in every 4 of the homeless population.

The annual total direct and indirect costs of child maltreatment are estimated to be nearly \$104 billion. Children left with no permanent family connections or a connection with a caring adult have no one to whom they can turn for social, emotional or financial support and face numerous barriers as they struggle to become self-sufficient adults.


