
THIS TUESDAY

Rick's talk was entitled "The Elephant in the Room" with long-tern care as the greatest threat. The new buzz words now are "Adult Day Care" and "Residential Care Homes". Long Term Care is very expensive and the averages stay is between 2-3 years. Rick explained a way of not paying further premiums and using the benefits up to that amount. Skilled Nursing care and cost upwards of \$7,500 a month for your loved ones.
