THIS TUESDAY

We will NOT be meeting at the famous Denny's this Tuesday because our room will be used for election polling. Instaed, we will meet at the Temple City Unified District office at 3:00 p.m. to welcome almost 40 new teachers and administrative staff.

LAST TUESDAY

Our speaker for the day was Matt Smith who gave of an account of his neice's hike on the Pacific Trail. The 2,650 miles began at the Southern border of Mexico and ended at the Canadian border near British Columbia. The 50 hikers released daily ranged elevations from sea level to 13,000 feet.

The route is mostly through National Forest and protected wilderness. The trail avoids civilization and covers scenic and pristine mountainous terrain with few roads. It passes through the Laguna, Santa Rosa, San Jacinto, San Bernardino, San Gabriel, Liebre, Tehachapi, Sierra Nevada, and Klamath ranges in California, and the Cascade Range in California, Oregon, and Washington. California is 1,689 miles long and is about 2/3 of the hike.

They fought the elements including 3 fires, temperatures ranging from freezing to 102 degrees. One good thing, they were greeted at campsites by Trail Angels. These are folks that have previously completed the hike and were there to help and encourage those making the hike.

The first person to thru-hike the entire PCT both ways in a single continuous round-trip was Scott Williamson, who completed the "yo-yo" circuit on his fourth attempt in November 2004. Williamson traveled a total of 5,300 miles in 197 days, covering an average of 35 to 40 miles per day when not in snow - an overall average of 27 miles per day. Williamson then went on to complete a second round trip on November 28, 2006, cutting two weeks off his 2004 time. The youngest person to hike the trail is Christian Thomas Geiger, who at the age of 6 completed the 2686 mile trail with his parents Andrea Rego and Dion Pagonis. Christian, also known by his trail name Buddy Backpacker, is also the youngest person to hike the Appalachian Trail.
