Bill Frank, an electrical engineer from Mc Donnel Douglas will speak on computers. Where they came from and how they have advanced. Such things as computers and geoscopic cameras.

LAST TUESDAY

Dale Buckeridge was our featured speaker for the day. He was born and raised in Temple City. He took his first flight in a Sheriff helicopter at the age of eight, and twenty years later he would be fixing them.

He graduated Temple City High School in 1969 and began his aviation career in 1971. In 1979 he received a call from the Sheriff's Department, he has been with the Aero Bureau for the past 38 years. In 1976 his dad was a Lockheed mechanic, his brother was a major Space Shuttle engineer, and he was a Army flight test mechanic. Currently he is working on his FAA Drone License.

The LASD Aero Bureau is located on Lakewood Blvd at the Long Beach airport in Long Beach California. Presently the LASD Aero Bureau operates a total of 18 helicopters making it the largest fleet of helicopters operated by any Sheriff's Department in the U.S. This would be appropriate since the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department is the largest sheriff's department in the world with over 8,500 sworn deputies and another 5,800 civilian employees.

Only the Los Angeles Police Department Air Support Division boast a larger fleet of helicopters but only by one. LAPD still claims to operate the largest "municipal airborne law enforcement operation in the world" with 14 Eurocopter (now Airbus) AS350 B2 helicopters and 5 Bell Jet Ranger helicopters.
