### LAST TUESDAY

Our featured speaker was Afi Bell. She is an author and spokeswoman dealing with Epilepsy. Currently Afi is affiliated with the Epilepsy Foundation. She understands that an informed community is a strong community. She has over eighteen years of personal epilepsy experiences.

Epilepsy is a group of neurological disorders characterized by epileptic seizures. Epileptic seizures are episodes that can vary from brief and nearly undetectable periods to long periods of vigorous shaking. These episodes



can result in physical injuries, including occasionally broken bones. In epilepsy, seizures tend to recur and, as a rule, have no immediate underlying cause. Isolated seizures that are provoked by a specific cause such as poisoning are not deemed to represent epilepsy.

The cause of most cases of epilepsy is unknown. Some cases occur as the result of brain injury, stroke, brain tumors, infections of the brain, and birth defects through a process known as epileptogenesis.

Afi is the author of "Living Free With Epilepsy", she updates society on famous people who have had epilepsy and didn't let it hold them down. We learned that there are over 40 types of epilepsy. It ranges from blacking out for a few minutes to a Gran Mal Seizure. It a seizure last less then 5 minutes there is no need to call 911.

Afi, because of her 19 year bout with epilepsy she cannot drive. She could be sitting at a bus bench and find herself at Target not knowing how she got there. She had 4 seizures just last month. She wears medical bracelets with her medical information.
