We don't have the final numbers in yet but everyone seemed to be happy, we served 134 people.

Our speaker for the day was Levy Sun. He is the public information officer for the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito & Vector Control District. Levy is an advocate of public health and the shared responsibility of mosquito control.

**Mosquitos & Disease:** Mosquitoes can be annoying, but they are most important as vectors (transmitters) of disease. Nearly 70% of emerging threats to public health worldwide are diseases of animals transmitted to humans. Diseases once nearly eradicated are making a comeback in the United States and around the world.

The entire life cycle from egg to adult takes an average of five to seven days for most species. Mosquitos are small biting flies no bigger than a half inch. They are out for blood, your blood. People often confuse the harmless Midges, Black Fly, and Crane Flies with Mosquitos. Remember, if it is bigger than your thumbnail then it is not a mosquito.

Mosquitos of concern include Culex, Anopheles, Aedes, Culiseta. The big ones are the Zika Virus, Dengue, Yellow Fever, and Chikungunya. What can you do to avoid being bitten? Apply a repellent that contains DEET, Picaridin, IR3535, or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus. Wear protective clothing, such as long-sleeved shirts and pants, Check and repair all screens and screen doors to keep mosquitos out of your house, and minimize outdoor activities at dawn and dusk when mosquitos are most active. Remove all standing contaminated water where they breed.
