Our speaker for the day was our own Steve Tyre who took visited Isreal, including the West Bank and the Gaza Strip. Steve provided photos of this spectacular trip with his wife Monica to the birthplace of Christ.

The Four Quarters of the Old City of Jerusalem are The Jewish Quarter, Muslim Quarter, Armenian Quarter (my favorite), and the Christian Quarter. The Jewish Quarter is located just west of the Western Wall. The Jewish Quarter is a thriving modern community with more than 1,000 families. It has been rebuilt out of the rubble that was left from Jordanian occupation of the area from 1948 until the Six Day War of 1967. Since the destruction was severe, the Jews who returned to the Old City in 1967 excavated the guarter's archaeological remains first and then built their city over, around and beside the ancient discoveries. Today there are numerous synagogues and schools for Jewish studies, along with contemporary shops and restaurants up and down the streets.

Little known facts about Israel: There are over 100 sushi restaurants in Tel Aviv...making it the city with the most sushi restaurants per capita after Tokyo and NYC. It has the highest rate of entrepreneurship among women and people over 55 in the world. Israel was the first country to ban underweight models. Israeli banknotes have braille markings on them. 9. Israelis consume the third most amount of vegetables and sweets in the world. When Golda Meir became prime minister of Israel in 1969, she was only the third woman elected to lead a country in the modern world. There's a rollerblading party that happens every Tuesday night in Tel Aviv. In regards to its population, Israel has the highest ratio of college degrees, ratio of its museums and startup companies. Motorola developed the cell phone in Israel. Voicemail technology was developed in Israel. Israel published more books translated from other languages than any other nation in the world.
