TCSF provides funding and support for enrichment programs, classroom grants, student-led projects, visual and performing arts, athletic teams and so much more.

Temple City Schools Foundation was founded in 2002 as a 501 (C) 3 non-profit organization. The only funds they receive are from Summer School and their Gala which is scheduled for May 4, 2019. They have given over \$1,000,000 in grants to deserving teachers and programs with over \$100,000 projected to be given this year. We thanked Marty for being with us by giving her a \$50 gift certificate to Moffet's Chicken Pie Restaurant.
