Our featured speaker for the day was our own member Bob Westgate. After his duties at Emperor he was appointed last year as Principal of the of the Dr. Doug Sears Learning Center (DDSLC).

Bob is in the midst of trying to outline the history of the Learning Center. Prior to the mid-seventies it was known simply as Continuation School. Later the Learning Center was known as South High School. Later it became the Community Learning Center. On November 24, 2008 the Learning Center was officially renamed the Dr. Doug Sears Learning Center.

On any given week between 200 to 250 students come through the DDSLC. There are times when three generations of family members attend alternative learning. There is a 80% accuracy when identifying a Kindergartner that someday will be involved in alternative education. The programs consist of Alternative High School, Adult School, and K-12 online. There are many success stories that have been told through the years with non-traditional education. Ninety-Five percent of DDSLC graduates go on to community college.

The **Vision** of the DDSLC is to empower students to become productive citizens by developing the skills necessary to promote self worth, independence, knowledge and creativity necessary to adapt to a world of accelerating change within a safe, secure and supportive environment.

The **Mission** of the DDSLC is designed to give students an opportunity to complete their high school education in an alternative setting, becoming productive citizens and lifelong learners. The program is non-traditional, self paced and utilizes authentic assessment to create a life skills learning experience which assumes more of students, school, home and community interaction.

The secret handshake was Bob Westgate. Cindy Vance has become a candidate for the School Board election in November. Steve Montesanti is happy there are only 6 more meetings during his presidency. Concerts in the Park grossed the highest amount in history with \$474. Ron Dorazio will be celebrating his birthday on August 10. Matt Smith was almost ready to give the barbecue finances, but decided to wait until next week.
