Our program for the day was Chris Saccente. Chris became a member of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society in February, 2018 and serves as Chair of the Fundraising Team.

In her free time, Chris advocates for community service, social justice, animal welfare and environmental issues. In addition , she is a active member and delegate of the League of Woman Voters-Pasadena Area.



The Society's Founder was Mrs. Fannie Thompson became an outspoken advocate for animal rights. She organized the American Animal Defense League to combat cruelty in the training of animals for vaudeville, movies and circuses. In 1924, at the age of 65, she founded the Alhambra-San Gabriel Humane Society, which provided services for both farm and domestic animals. The shelter doubles in size when its neighbor property was donated in the interest of Fannie's humanitarian work. Today, the SGVHS focuses on the care and placement of family pets.

Mission Statement: The San Gabriel Valley Humane Society is committed to provide a compassionate environment for the well-being of the animals in our care. With the dedication of our staff and volunteers, we strive to find permanent, loving homes for all of our companion animals and provide opportunities to enhance the human animal bond.

I have a genuine affection for the SGVHS, having received my first dog from there 65 years ago. They took in 2,300 animals in 2017 and adopted out 650. They have recently made some upgrades to the facility including condos for cats and increasing the dog capacity from 70 to 100. All of this is done with 20 staff members and the most important part, 125 volunteers.
