Many years ago Mary was not feeling well and found herself at Arcadia Methodist with a diagnosis of lymphoma with only 2 weeks to live. Having served in the healthcare industry all her life decided to visit a doctor friend at Huntington Hospital. Suddenly fifteen doctors showed up in her room and a new better diagnosis of a rare auto-immune disease was treated. She then vowed to devote her life in serving others.

In 2007 Mary decided to start her own non-profit service connecting seniors with free resources and referrals to educate, inform and enhance the lives of seniors and their families. Their services include Alzheimer's and Demential Care, Assisted Living, Board and Care Homes, Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly, and Independent Living.

Mary and her organization, Autumn Years is partnering with Temple City in serving the homebound and disabled in Temple City with delivered lunch and dinner meals. The application process is easy and the costs is nominal with \$3.50 for lunch and dinner at \$4.50.
